We are going to develop our speaking and listening skills as we share our ideas about what we have been doing and special times in our lives.

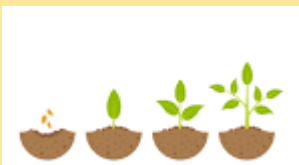
Topic

Our topic this term is 'Everything grows...'

We will be exploring how plants, people and animals grow through immersive learning experiences and becoming independent learners.

We will be focusing on fiction books to look at the setting, characters and events in a story.

We shall also discuss what the characters are doing, their feelings and what we think might happen next



Literacy

We are looking at tales such as Jack and the beanstalk, Jasper's Beanstalk and Ed's egg – to link to chicks hatching!

We will be looking at the way stories are structured, the setting, characters and events in the stories as well.

We shall also discuss how the different characters might be feeling and learning repeated refrains e.g Fee-fi-fo! And saying it in a Giant's booming voice!

Maths

This term we will continue to explore number through counting objects, recognising numerals and solving practical calculations such as matching quantities of objects to the correct numeral.

We will be looking at positional language and using shapes to build or make patterns with.

Please remember to **bring a bag with a change of clothes in it for your child**. Please ensure that they have a coat for when we go outside and wellies are great if it has been raining.

Please let your children wear clothes they can get MESSY in – we shall be having fun inside and outside!
