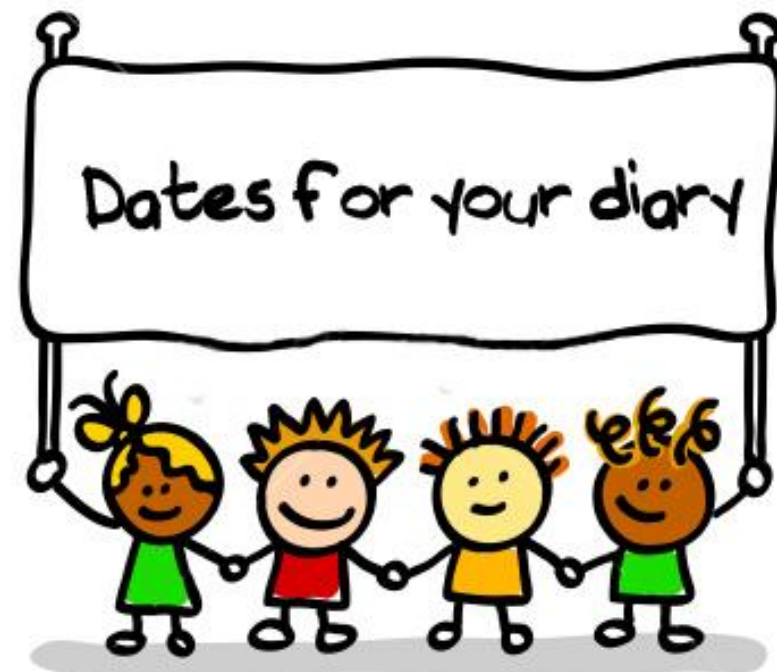


## Reception at DIA...

# Key dates...

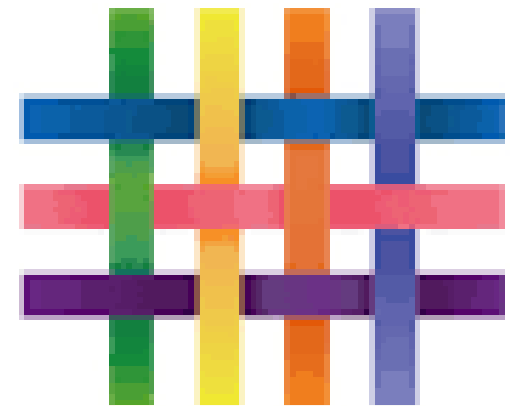

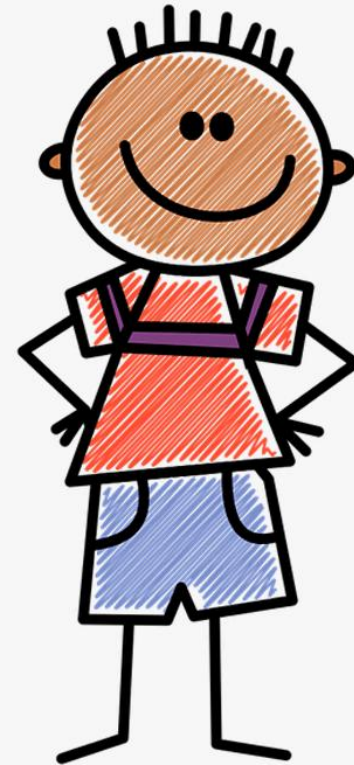

# What can I do to support at home?

---

- We ask that in preparation for coming to Reception, that children are encouraged to start dressing themselves and begin to manage their own personal needs.
- Counting objects- when you are out for a walk or in the car counting things and using number language.
- Recognising their own name- writing this at home and being able to recognise what their name looks like.
- Toileting- being able to manage their own toilet needs.
- See the getting ready for school checklist in your information packs.



# What will I need?

---

- Uniform- see the uniform table set up today to see sizing and order information.
- Book Bag- these can be ordered at the uniform table- rucksacks are not needed.
- PE Kit- PE tops can be ordered with uniform.
- Wellies- We ask that all children bring in a pair of wellies which can be left in the classroom for our outdoor learning.
- Lunch box or order from Kingswood Catering- information about this is in your packs.
- Water bottle- to bring into the classroom each day
