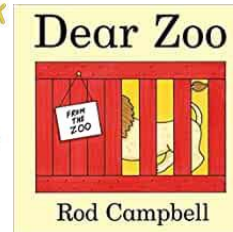
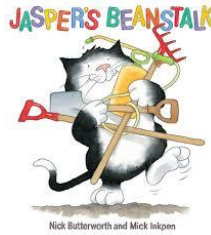

How do things grow and change?

Reading/Physical Development/Writing

- Repeats words or phrases from a familiar story
- Suggests how a story might end
- Drawing a picture of a plant, animal
- 'labelling' parts of a plant
- Letter shapes for s,a,t,p,i,n

Number/Shape, space and measure

- Recites numbers in order (to 10)
- Compares 2 groups of objects, saying when they have the same number
- Interest in shapes in the environment
- Using language of size
- Talk about the shapes of everyday objects, eg round and tall
- Shows awareness of similarities of shapes in the environment

Understanding the World

- Discussing spring time, what it looks like
- Commenting on the world around them
- People and Communities- knows what makes them unique and what makes them similar to friends and family
- Shows care and concern for living things and the environment

Expressive Art & Design

- Move to music and action songs
- Join in singing favourite songs
- Role play – a plant growing from a seed, being a zoo animal
- Flower pictures
