Basic Skills	If asked by a child: adult will supervise the children in logging on and use of apps within airhead
Core Skills	
	Children should be shown: How to open the apps within airhead How to interact with them Then when showing an interest to use this independently should be assisted in logging on.
	Children should have access to a variety of IT equipment, tablet, computer, camera, bee bots, tills, talking tins, sound buttons and a variety of real-life equipment such as washing machines and microwaves etc and know the uses of each of them.
	Children should be exposed to a variety of different apps and websites by the time that they leave EYFS.  They know that different apps will serve different purposes and functions  Begin to choose the correct app for the functionality required.
Word	Children should be able to experience typing/writing on a computer or touch screen device. (Such as on apps like writing repeater within airhead.) This also has a simplistic save version - so the children, with adult supervision, can begin to learn to save and open documents.
